

Requirements for graduation regarding foreign language competency

Precondition to complete studies for BA degree (Level I) in ASC UW is, prior to the end of the third year of studies, master one foreign language (other than English) and successfully pass the exam for Certificate of Competency in Foreign Language on level B2. Exams for the certificate are given periodically by the School of Foreign Languages UW. **

Below you will find English translation of the University of Warsaw Language School information for students seeking the necessary Certificate:

1. Pursuant to the Senate UW Resolution Nr 119, passed on June 17, 2009, the precondition of graduation both BA and MA level is mastering one foreign language at least at B2 level according to the European System of Language Education of the European Union. This obligation can be fulfilled by passing certificate examination offered by UW School of Foreign Languages or by presenting a language certificate honored at UW.***

According to the Rector's Rule nr 24 dated May 25, 2007.

2. Students may take the examination using the "chip" (zeton) or paying for the exam in chosen foreign language on a given level.

2. Students of such disciplines as literature, linguistics and cultural studies (kulturoznawstwo) must achieve certificate in a language other than the main language of their discipline.

**The UW School of Foreign Languages offers examinations in 38 languages including Albanian, Arabic, Belorussian, Russian, Ukrainian, Georgian, Bulgarian, Chinese, French, Greek, German, Hebrew, Spanish, Polish, Japanese, Lithuanian, Italian, Portuguese, Swedish, Norwegian, Persian etc.
